Soumen Ghosh is a professor of operations and supply chain management in the Scheller College of Business at Georgia Institute of Technology (Georgia Tech), located in Atlanta. He is also the Faculty Director for executive education programs for corporate customers. He also provides consulting and training services to organizations in several countries in the areas of supply chain strategy and world class supply chain capability development.
